What does the Bible claim?

1. It is the word of God, not the word of man.

For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but for what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Hebrews 4:12

2. It is <u>inspired</u> by God, not <u>invented</u> by man.

All Scripture is inspired by God 2 Timothy 3:16

... for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. 2 Peter 1:21

3. It is the <u>truth</u> of God, not the <u>musings</u> of man.

Sanctify them in truth; Your word is truth. John 17:17
