FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT Isaiah 9:1-7 Jeff Schreve


But there will be no more gloom for her who was in anguish; in earlier times He treated the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali with contempt, but later on He shall make it glorious, by the way of the sea, on the other side of Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles. The people who walk in darkness Will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, The light will shine on them. Isaiah 9:1-2

Those people lived in darkness, but they will see a great light. They lived in a place as dark as death, but a great light will shine on them. This will happen when the special child is born. God will give us a son who will be responsible for leading the people. His name will be "Wonderful Counselor, Powerful God, Father Who Lives Forever, Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:2, 6 ERV

How does this baby change everything for Israel ... and for us?

1. The Messiah will bring light to spiritual darkness.

Now when He heard that John had been taken into custody. He withdrew into Galilee; and leaving Nazareth, He came and settled in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali. This was to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet saying, "THE LAND OF ZEBULUN AND THE LAND OF NAPHTALI, BY THE WAY OF THE SEA, BEYOND THE JORDAN. GALILEE OF THE GENTILES—THE PEOPLE WHO WERE SITTING IN DARKNESS SAW A GREAT LIGHT, AND TO THOSE WHO WERE SITTING IN THE LAND AND SHADOW OF DEATH, UPON THEM A LIGHT DAWNED." From that time Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 4:12-17



- A. Without Jesus, our lives are <u>dark</u>, <u>gloomy</u>, and <u>hopeless</u>.

 Remember that in the past you were without Christ. You had no hope, and you did not know God. Ephesians 2:12 ERV
- B. With Jesus, our lives can be full of glory, joy, and victory. You shall multiply the nation, You shall increase their gladness; They will be glad in Your presence As with the gladness of harvest, As men rejoice when they divide the spoil. For You shall break the yoke of their burden and the staff on their shoulders, The rod of their oppressor, as at the battle of Midian. Isaiah 9:3-4

2. The Messiah will be given for the sins of the world.
