You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, these entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also. How can you be a GOOD soldier of Christ Jesus?

- 1. Understand that you don't have what it takes, but He does.
 - A. The Christian life is all about grace and faith.
- B. We grow strong in grace through <u>prayer</u> and <u>the Word</u>. For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:15-16

2. Understand that there will be suffering and hardships.

A. The world hates the message of the gospel.

"And this is the judgment, that the light is come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the light; for their deeds were evil. For everyone who does evil hates the light, and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed." John 3:19-20

- B. The world will persecute those who stand up for Jesus. Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord or of me His prisoner, but join with me in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God. 2 Timothy 1:8
- 3. Understand that your #1 job is to please the Lord.
