2. Every Christian can employ the grace and truth of Jesus.

A. Jesus is abounding in both grace and truth.



B. Jesus wants us to build our families on grace and truth.

1. Truth is the <u>foundation</u> for everything. Your kingdom is built on truth and justice. Psalm 89:14 ERV

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; Lovingkindness and truth go before You. Psalm 89:14 NAS

[Love] does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth. 1 Corinthians 13:6

2. Grace is the often-forgotten counterpart.

C. Jesus wants us to treat our family as <u>He treats us</u>. *The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen. Revelation 22:21*

1. Grace is not a license to sin.
