Why is it all about Jesus?

1. Jesus is the one and only God.

*Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: "I am the first and I am the last, and there is no God besides Me."
Isaiah 44:6*

*In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God,
and the Word was God. John 1:1*

A. Jesus is eternally God.

In the beginning God ... Genesis 1:1

B. Jesus is equally God.

C. Jesus is unequivocally God.

All things came into being by Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. John 1:3

2. Jesus is the one and only God-man.

And the Word became flesh ... John 1:14

A. Jesus became a man.

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh ... 1 Timothy 3:16

B. Jesus revealed the Father.

No one has ever seen God. But the unique One, who is Himself God, is near to the Father's heart. He has revealed God to us. John 1:18 NLT

3. Jesus is the one and only Savior.

"But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus, in the same way as they also are." Acts 15:11

A. Through Moses, we received the Law.

Obviously, the law applies to those to whom it was given, for its purpose is to keep people from having excuses, and to show that the entire world is guilty before God. For no one can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are. Romans 3:19-20

B. Through Jesus, we can receive life-changing grace.

For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace. For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ. John 1:16-17

He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:10-13
