What is the answer to an empty life?

For He has satisfied the thirsty soul, and the hungry soul He has filled with what is good. Psalm 107:9

1. Jesus cares about your emptiness.

- A. Your problems are not insignificant to Jesus.
- B. His initial response is often <u>a test</u>. *"Woman, what do I have to do with you? My hour has not yet come." John 2:4*

2. Jesus wants you to exercise faith in the face of emptiness.

- A. Faith is not <u>having it all figured out</u>.
 "O our God ... we are powerless before this great multitude who are coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are on You." 2 Chronicles 20:12
- B. Faith is <u>doing what He says</u>. *Whatever He says to you, do it. John 2:5*
 - 1. Do it, even if it is <u>tedious and tiresome</u>. Jesus said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them to the brim. John 2:7

2. Do it even if it <u>seems crazy</u>. And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the headwaiter." And they took it to him. John 2:8

3. Jesus wants to <u>fill</u> your emptiness.

- A. Religious ritual will never fill you.
- B. Jesus will fill you with the very best. "But I would feed you with the finest of the wheat; and with honey from the rock I would satisfy you." Psalm 81:16

... and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God. Ephesians 3:19
