God wants to shower His people with blessings!

The blessings of God are contingent on your obedience to God.

Now it shall be, if you will diligently obey the LORD your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you will obey the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 28:1-2

1. To obey God, you have to know what God says to do.

And the Lord shall make you the head and not the tail, and you only shall be above, and you shall not be underneath, if you will listen to the commandments of the LORD your God, which I charge you today, to observe them carefully. Deuteronomy 28:13
