For consider your calling, brethren ... 1 Corinthians 1:26

What do we learn when we consider our calling to Team God?

1. There are not many extraordinary people on God's team.

For consider your calling, brethren, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble. 1 Corinthians 1:26

A. These folks have a tendency to be proud.

Knowledge makes arrogant, but love edifies. 1 Corinthians 8:1

B. God does not work with the proud.

And all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble. 1 Peter 5:5

Everyone who is proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord; assuredly, he will not be unpunished. Proverbs 16:5

2. There are lots of ordinary people on God's team.

... but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, and the base things of the world and the despised, God has chosen, the things that are not, that He might nullify the things that are ... 1 Corinthians 1:27-28

- A. These folks tend to be more open to God.
- B. These folks tend to see their need more readily.

3. There is only one star on God's team.

B. The Lord works through the team.
