Now concerning the things about which you wrote ... 1 Corinthians 7:1

What does God say about love and marriage?

1. Marriage is not for everyone.

Yes, it is good to live a celibate life. 1 Corinthians 7:1 NLT

A. It is good to be single.

An unmarried man can spend his time doing the Lord's work and thinking how to please Him. But a married man has to think about his earthly responsibilities and how to please his wife. His interests are divided. 1 Corinthians 7:33-34 NLT

B. It is a gift from God to be single.

But I wish everyone were single, just as I am. But God gives to some the gift of marriage, and to others the gift of singleness. 1 Corinthians 7:7 NLT

2. Marriage is for most everyone.

But because of immoralities, each man is to have his own wife, and each woman is to have her own husband. 1 Corinthians 7:2

A. It is good to be married.

Enjoy life with the woman whom you love all the days of your fleeting life which He has given to you under the sun; for this is your reward in life and in your toil in which you have labored under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:9

B. It is God's default setting.

And God blessed them; and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth ..." Genesis 1:28

3. Marriage is the only place for physical love.

Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled for fornicators and adulterers God will judge. Hebrews 13:4

A. God created sex to be <u>pleasurable</u>.

How beautiful are your feet in sandals, O prince's daughter! The curves of your hips are like jewels, the work of the hands of an artist. Your navel is like a round goblet which never lacks mixed wine; your belly is like a heap of wheat fenced about with lilies. Your two breasts are like two fawns, twins of a gazelle.
