CONCERNING SPIRITUAL GIFTS

Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be unaware.

1 Corinthians 12:1

What does God want us to know about spiritual gifts?

- 1. Spiritual gifts can be confused.
 - A. The devil wants to <u>confuse</u>, <u>syncretize</u> and <u>lead astray</u>.

 You know that when you were pagans, you were led astray
 to the dumb idols, however you were led. 12:2
 - B. The devil wants to <u>counterfeit the work of God</u>.

 Therefore I make known to you, that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. 12:3
- 2. Spiritual gifts need to be understood.
 - A. They are <u>supernatural gifts and abilities</u>.
 - B. They are <u>divinely distributed</u>.

 It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts.

 He alone decides which gift each person should have.

12:11 NLT

C. They are given to promote unity, not disunity.

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. And there are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. 12:4-6

D. They are <u>tools</u> to benefit the <u>congregation</u>, not <u>toys</u> to benefit the individual.

But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 12:7

3. Spiritual gifts give evidence that God is at work.

A. There are <u>sign</u> gifts to <u>establish and authenticate</u> the church.

The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with all perseverance, by signs and wonders and miracles.

2 Corinthians 12:12

So then tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe, but to unbelievers; but prophecy is for a sign not to unbelievers but to believers. 1 Corinthians 14:22

B. There are <u>practical</u> gifts to <u>strengthen</u> the church.

And since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let each exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith; if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; or he who exhorts, in his exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness. Romans 12:6-8
