BREAKING THE SPELL

Galatians 3:1-14 Jeff Schreve

Oh, foolish Galatians! What magician has cast an evil spell on you? Galatians 3:1

Why is a legalistic, works salvation God so appealing?

- 1. It appeals to the <u>flesh</u> and the <u>boastful pride of life</u>.
- 2. It appeals to the physical senses.
- 3. It appeals to our desire to <u>compare</u> and <u>keep score</u>.

How do you break the spell of a legalistic, works salvation?

1. Understand how the Christian life starts.

You foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified? This is the only thing I want to find out from you: did you receive the Spirit by the works of the Law, or by hearing with faith? Galatians 3:1-2

- A. It is rooted in the death, burial, and empty tomb of Christ.
- B. It is a result of repentance and faith in Jesus Christ.

C. It brings us the Holy Spirit.

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation--having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory. Ephesians 1:13-14

2. Understand how the Christian life grows.

A. It grows by walking in the Spirit, not working in the flesh.

Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? Did you suffer so many things in vain - if indeed it was in vain? Galatians 3:4-5

B. It grows by letting Christ live through you by faith. Does He then, who provides you with the Spirit and works miracles among you, do it by the works of the Law, or by hearing with faith? Galatians 3:5

C. It stops growing the moment you <u>get in the flesh</u>. ... and those who are in the flesh cannot please God. Romans 8:8

How can you tell if you have the real thing and going in the right direction?

You have the fruit of the Spirit present in your life.
