Brethren, even if a man is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, each one looking to yourself, lest he too be tempted. Galatians 6:1

- Q. What does real Christianity look like?
- A. It looks like **Jesus**.
- 1. Real Christianity is actively involved in restoring the fallen.
 - A. Jesus wants us to help and heal, not condemn.

 God sent his Son into the world, not to condemn the world, but to save the world. John 3:17
 - B. Jesus wants us to be gentle, not harsh.
 - C. Jesus wants us to be <u>humble</u>, not <u>proud and self-righteous</u>.
- **2.** Real Christianity is actively involved in <u>bearing burdens</u>.

 Bear one another's burdens and thus fulfill the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2
 - A. Jesus wants us to <u>make loads lighter</u>, not <u>heavier</u>.

 And they tie up heavy loads, and lay them on men's shoulders;
 but they themselves are unwilling to move them with so
 much as a finger. Matthew 23:4
 - B. Jesus wants us to give <u>rest</u> and <u>renewed strength</u>.

 Come to Me all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Matthew 11:28

3. Real Christianity is actively involved in godly living.

A. Jesus wants us to <u>fully depend upon Him</u>.

For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself. Galatians 6:3

... for apart from Me, you can do nothing. John 15:5

B. Jesus wants us to fully focus on Him.

Not that we dare to classify or compare ourselves with some of those who are commending themselves. But when they measure themselves by one another and compare themselves with one another, they are without understanding.

C. Jesus wants us to <u>take personal responsibility for our lives</u>.
