1. God loves it when you give.

A. You imitate God when you give.

Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. Ephesians 5:1

B. You exercise faith when you give.

C. You bless God’s heart when you give.

*Let each one do just as he has purposed in his heart; not grudgingly or
under compulsion; for God loves a cheerful giver. 2 Corinthians 9:7*

2. God warns you when you give.

A. Don’t give with prideful motives.

*But a certain man named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold
a piece of property, and kept back some of the price for himself,
with his wife’s full knowledge, and bringing a portion of it, he
laid it at the apostles’ feet. Acts 5:1-2*

B. Don’t give with selfish motives.

3. God blesses you when you give.
