THE GOOD NEWS ABOUT BAD TIMES

James 1:1-4 Jeff Schreve

Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. James 1:2-3

Is there really any good news when you are facing bad times?

1. There is the good news of God's grace.

- A. Bad times always <u>humble us</u>. For they have turned their back to Me, and not their face; but in the time of their trouble they will say, "Arise and save us." Jeremiah 2:27
- B. Humility always <u>ushers in the grace of God</u>. But He gives a greater grace. There it says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble." James 4:6

2. There is good news of God's work.

- A. God uses trials to test the <u>authenticity</u> of our faith. And the one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word, and immediately receives it with joy; yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away. Matthew 13:20-21
- B. God uses trials to test the <u>strength</u> of our faith. *Consider it all joy ... James 1:2*

C. God uses trials to <u>help us grow</u>.

... knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. James 1:3-4

D. God uses trials to <u>make us shine for Him</u>. When He has tried me, I shall come forth as gold. Job 23:10

3. There is the good news of God's reward.

Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. James 1:12

- B. God will reward <u>all those who stay true to Him</u>.
