HOW TO SEE THE GLORY OF GOD

John 11:1-46

Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you, if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" John 11:40

Are you willing to do what it takes to see God's glory?

1. Start viewing your problems in a different way.

The sisters therefore sent to Him, saying, "Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick." John 11:3

- A. Bring your problems to Jesus.
- B. Know that your problems are <u>opportunities in disguise</u>.

 But when Jesus heard it, He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified by it." John 11:4
- 2. Start <u>clinging to the promises of God</u>, no matter what.
 - A. God's promises are often <u>misunderstood</u> but never <u>false</u>.
 - B. God's timing is almost always <u>later than ours</u>.
- 3. Start obeying the Word of God, even if it makes no sense.

Jesus said, "Remove the stone." John 11:39

- A. Faith is always evidenced by action.
- B. Faith is always <u>needed in order for God to work</u>.
- 4. Start living with expectation in your heart.
