"Hear, O My people, and I will admonish [solemnly warn] you; O Israel, if you would listen to Me!" Psalm 81:8

1. The LORD is to be the One you <u>listen to</u> and <u>obey</u>.

A. He is the true God.

"Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me" Isaiah 46:9

"For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, The fountain of living waters, To hew for themselves cisterns, Broken cisterns, That can hold no water." Jeremiah 2:13

- B. He is the <u>redeeming</u> God.
- C. He is the <u>abundantly satisfying</u> God.

2. The LORD is to be the One you fear and revere.

For the LORD Most High is to be feared, A great King over all the earth.

Psalm 47:2

"But My people did not listen to My voice; And Israel did not obey Me.
So I gave them over to the stubbornness of their heart, To walk in

A. His heart breaks when you sin and rebel.

B. His heart breaks over what might have been.

"I would quickly subdue their enemies, And turn My hand against their adversaries. Those who hate the LORD would pretend obedience to Him; And their time of punishment would be forever. But I would feed you with the finest of the wheat; And with honey from the rock I would satisfy you." Psalm 81:14-16
