# <u>**TESTING THE SPIRITS**</u> 1 John 4:1-6 Jeff Schreve

Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. 1 John 4:1

# Do you put teachers and their teaching to the test?

## 1. Test their doctrine concerning Christ.

By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God; and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God; and this is the spirit of the antichrist, of which you have heard that it is coming, and now it is already in the world, 1 John 4:2-3

- A. False teachers will always have a false Christology. For if one comes and preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted, you bear this beautifully. 2 Corinthians 11:4
  - They will deny His full deity and humanity.
- B. False teachers will not submit to Christ as Lord. Therefore I make known to you, that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:3

#### 2. Test their doctrine concerning salvation.

But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil. 1 Thessalonians 5:21-22

- A. Do they preach the word and emphasize salvation? Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were entreating through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 2 Corinthians 5:20
- B. Do they add works to faith in Christ?

# C. Do they remove <u>repentance</u> from faith in Christ? ... unless you repent, you will all likewise perish. Luke 13:3, 5

## 3. Test their audience to see who is listening.

You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world. They are from the world; therefore they speak as from the world, and the world listens to them. We are from God; he who knows God listens to us; he who is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error. 1 John 4:4-6

### A. Does the world embrace them?

"If the world hates you, you know that it has hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you." John 15:18-19
