How can you fulfill your assignment from King Jesus?

1. Develop sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.

A. Take time to hear Him.

Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening. 1 Samuel 3:9

B. Take no time to obey Him.

Arise and go south... And he arose and went. Acts 8:26-27

2. Develop sensitivity to people's spiritual condition.

A. Every person is lost without Jesus.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me." John 14:6

B. Many people are religious but lost.

C. Many people are seeking and need your guidance.

"Well, how could I, unless someone guides me?" Acts 8:31

3. Develop clarity in your witness for Jesus.
