Would you like to start getting your prayers answered?

1. Pray with purity.

A. Your heart has to be right.

If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me. Psalm 66:18

B. Your relationship with God has to be growing.

The effective prayer of a **righteous** man can accomplish much. James 6:16

2. Pray with honesty.

A. Share your deepest needs and desires with God.

Trust in Him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before Him; God is a refuge for us. Psalm 62:8

B. Remember that God is a good God.

Delight yourself in the Lord; and He will give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:4

3. Pray with expectation.

Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know. Jeremiah 33:3 NKJV

A. Don't get derailed with delays.

But as for me, I will hope continually, and will praise You yet more and more. Psalm 71:14

B. Don't stop doing what is right.

Now it came about, while he was performing his priestly service before God in the appointed order of his division ... Luke 1:8

And let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we shall reap if we do not grow weary. Galatians 6:9

C. Don't lose sight of God's great heart.

But the angel said to him, "Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your petition has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you will give him the name John. Luke 1:13
