#### What can we learn about prayer from the life of Nehemiah?

#### 1. Prayer should start with praise.

#### 2. Prayer must include <u>confession</u>.

### 5. Prayer doesn't give up.

#### 7. Prayer needs to be coupled with plans.

The horse is prepared for the day of battle, but victory belongs to the LORD. Proverbs 21:31
