Q. What is God's message when you feel insecure and inferior?

A. Your self-worth is being threatened.

How can you turn your inferiority into victory?

1. Believe the truth that you have infinite worth.

Jesus, knowing ... that He had come forth from God... John 13:3

A. God created you in His image.

And God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:27

I will give Thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Psalm 139:14

B. God thinks so highly of you.

Since you are precious in My sight, Since you are honored and I love you, I will give other men in your place and other peoples in exchange for your life. Isaiah 43:4

C. God paid so much for you.

...knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ. 1 Peter 1:18-19

2. Believe the truth that you have incredible wealth.
