

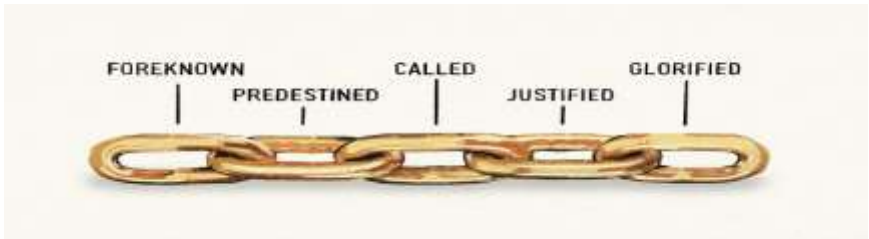

Romans 8:31-39 Jeff Schreve

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the first-born among many brethren; and whom He predestined, these He also called; and whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified. Romans 8:29-30



What then shall we say to these things? Romans 8:31

Is anything able to break the chain of eternal salvation?

1. God the Father will not break the chain.

A. He is for us ... so who can stand against us?

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

Romans 8:32

B. He has declared that we are “not guilty” in Jesus Christ.

Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies. Romans 8:33

2. God the Son will not break the chain.

... who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

Romans 8:34

A. He does not condemn us ... he died to save us.

B. He is constantly praying for us.

My little children, I am writing these things to you that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 1 John 2:1

3. The devil and bad circumstances cannot break the chain.

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Just as it is written, "FOR THY SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED." But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. Romans 8:34-37

*** The devil and his schemes cannot take you from His hand.**

*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable and undefiled and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you, **who are protected by the power of God** through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 1 Peter 1:3-5*

4. You yourself cannot break the chain.
