How can we overcome our fears and step out in faith?

1. You must remember that God has a plan.

A. God knows how much you can take.

...God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able... 1 Corinthians 10:13

B. He knows exactly what He is doing.

"I will be honored through Pharaoh and his all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD." Exodus 14:4

2. You must keep your eyes on the Lord.

A. You can choose what you focus on.

O our God will you not judge them? For we are powerless before this great multitude who are coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are on You. 2 Chronicles 20:12

B. Focusing on your problems always produces fear.

For God has not given us a spirit of fear... 2 Timothy 1:7

3. You must take that step of faith.

1. Real faith believes God.

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

2. Real faith obeys God.

3. Real faith experiences God.
