Take care, brethren, lest there should be in any one of you and evil, unbelieving heart, in falling away from the living God. Hebrews 3:12

What happens if you live your life in unbelief?

- 1. You will lose sight of God's track record.
 - A. God has proven that He will come through. How long will this people spurn Me? And how long will they not believe in Me, despite all the signs which I have performed in their midst? Numbers 14:11
 - B. God has proven that the worst situation is not too difficult. Ah Lord God! Behold You have made the heavens and the earth by Your power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You. Jeremiah 32:17
- 2. You will forfeit the power of God's Word.
 - A. God's Word makes a difference in you when you believe it. For indeed we have had good news preached to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united by faith in those who heard. Hebrews 4:2
 - B. If you believe God's promises will not work, they won't. For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through Him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 1:20

3. You will miss out on God's abundance.

Behold, you shall see it with your own eyes, but you shall not eat of it. 2 Kings 7:2

1. God wants you to abound in blessings.

The LORD be magnified, who delights in the prosperity of His servant. Proverbs 35:27

2. You will not abound if you will not believe.

As I swore in My wrath, they shall not enter My rest. And so we see that they were not able to enter because of unbelief.

Hebrews 3:11, 19
