How can you really get free of the pit?

1. To get free of the pit, you have to get honest.

Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, "Where are you?" Genesis 3:9

A. Are you in a place of darkness?

There were those who dwelt in darkness and in the shadow of death...
Psalm 107:10

B. Are you in a place of imprisonment?

For the LORD hears the needy and does not despise His who are prisoners. Psalm 69:33

C. Are you in a place of misery?

I am sated with disgrace and conscious of my misery. Job 10:15

2. To get out of the pit, you have to get serious.

Do you want to get well? John 5:6

A. You must cry out to the Lord.

1. He wants you to know He delivered you.

Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, He saved them out of their distresses. Psalm 107:13

2. He wants you to know Him.

B. You must confess your sins to the Lord.

...because they had rebelled against the words of God and spumed the counsel of the Most High. Psalm 107: 11

C. You must claim your deliverance.

He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and broke their bands apart. Let them give thanks to the LORD for His lovingkindness, and for His wonders to the sons of men!
