What two subjects does God want to teach us?

1. Anthropology: God wants to teach us about ourselves.

A. We are prone to get angry.

1. Anger comes from hurt.

And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

2. Anger comes from wanting control.

Cease striving and know that I am God. Psalm 46:10

3. Anger comes from pride.

When pride comes, then comes dishonor, but with the humble is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

B. We are prone to lose sight of our purpose.

So whether we are here in this body or away from this body, our goal is to please Him. 2 Corinthians 5:9 NLT

2. Theology: God wants to teach us about Himself.
