GOD'S FOREVER NAME

Exodus 3:10-15

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"This is what you're to say to the Israelites: 'The LORD (YHWH), the God of your fathers, of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, has sent me to you!' **This is My name forever**, and by this name I am to be remembered to all generations." Exodus 3:15 AMP

What does the name Jehovah/Yahweh teach us about God?

1. God is the source of life.

And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM"; and He said, "Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you." Exodus 3:14

- A. Jehovah/Yahweh comes from the verb "to be."
- B. Jehovah/Yahweh is the <u>creator and sustainer of life</u>.

 But the God in whose hand are your life-breath and your ways,

 you have not glorified. Daniel 5:23

...for in Him we live and move and exist... Acts 17:28

2. God is everything you need.

- A. I AM is <u>always present tense</u>.

 "I AM WHO I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN." Exodus 3:14
- B. I AM is an unfinished sentence.

 "I AM has sent me to you." Exodus 3:14

3. God became a man.

- A. Jesus boldly declared His deity before the <u>Jews</u>.

 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I AM." John 8:58
- B. Jesus boldly declared His deity before the <u>disciples</u>.

 But instantly He spoke to them, saying, "Take courage! IAM!

 Stop being afraid." Matthew 14:27 AMP
- C. Jesus boldly declared His deity before the Roman soldiers. Jesus therefore, knowing all the things that were coming upon Him, went forth, and said to them, "Whom do you seek?" They answered Him, "Jesus the Nazarene." He said to them, "I AM." John 18:4-5
- D. Jesus boldly declared His deity before the <u>Sanhedrin</u>.

 But He kept silent, and made no answer. Again the high priest was questioning Him, and saying to Him, "Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?" And Jesus said, "I AM; and you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven." Mark 14:61-62
