And Abraham called the name of that place The LORD Will Provide [YHWH-Jireh], as it is said to this day, "In the mount of the LORD it will be provided." Genesis 22:14

What can we learn about God from the name Jehovah-Jireh?

1. God sees all your needs.

* Pro –Vision means to see beforehand.

And when you are praying, do not use meaningless repetition, as the *Gentiles do, for they suppose that they will be heard for their many* words. Therefore do not be like them; for your Father knows what you need, before you ask Him. Matthew 6:7-8

2. God has provided for your greatest need.

A. Your greatest need is the forgiveness of your sins. And Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, "My father!" And he said, "Here I am, my son." And he said, "Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?" Genesis 22:7

B. Your greatest need was hard for God to meet. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice. saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" Matthew 27:46

C. Your greatest need required the death of God's own Son. He is not here, but He has risen. Remember how He spoke to you while He was still in Galilee, saying that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. Luke 24:6-7

3. God will provide for all your other needs.

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for

us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things? Romans 8:31-32

A. You must trust Him.

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love. 1 John 4:18

B. You must obey Him.

"By Myself I have sworn, declares the Lord, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, indeed I will greatly bless you... And in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, **because you have obeyed My voice.**" Genesis 22:16-18
