Why did God create marriage?

1. God created marriage for companionship.

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone; I will make him a helper suitable for him." Genesis 2:18

- A. God made Adam with an unmet need.
- B. God worked to help Adam see his need.

And the man gave names to all the cattle, and to the birds of the sky, and to every beast of the field, but for Adam there was not found a helper suitable for him. Genesis 2:20

C. God met Adam's need in Eve.

And the Lord God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man. Genesis 2:22

2. God created marriage for intimacy and oneness.

For this cause a man shall leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave to his wife; and they shall become one flesh. Genesis 2:24

A. He wants us to have spiritual intimacy.

Do not be bound together with unbelievers; for what partnership have righteousness and lawlessness, or what fellowship has light with darkness? Or what harmony has Christ with Belial, or what has a believer in common with an unbeliever? 2 Corinthians 6:14-15

- B. He wants us to have emotional intimacy.
- C. He wants us to have physical intimacy.

1. Sex in marriage is designed for pleasure.

Kiss me and kiss me again, for your love is sweeter than wine. Song of Solomon 1:2 NLT

2. Sex in marriage is designed for <u>procreation</u>.

Didn't the LORD make you one with your wife? In body and spirit you are his. And what does he want? Godly children from your union. So guard your heart; remain loyal to the wife of your youth. Malachi 2:15 NLT

3. God created marriage for our good and His glory.

A. Marriage is designed to be <u>awesome!</u>

"At last!" the man exclaimed. Genesis 2:23 NLT

B. Marriage is designed to picture Christ and the church.

As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one." This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one. Ephesians 5:31-32 NLT
