What do you do when you fear the uncertain future?

1. Remember that God is your refuge.

A. He will <u>shelter</u> you in every storm. You are my refuge in the day of disaster. Jeremiah 17:17

B. He wants you to <u>run to Him</u> in your trouble. *The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous runs into it and is safe.* Proverbs 18:10

2. Remember that God is your help.

A. He will give you <u>strength</u> in your storm. He gives strength to the weary, And to him who lacks might He increases power. Isaiah 40:29

B. He will give you joy in your storm. *There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy dwelling places of the Most High. Psalm 46:4*

3. Remember that God is in control.

A. He wants you to <u>relax</u>. Cease striving and know that I am God. Psalm 46:10

B. He wants you to trust Him.

C. He wants you to know He will be exalted.

I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted on the earth. Psalm 46:10
